Product Description

An unbroken linear effect is created by the individual members of the Au.diSlat Continuous planks. Separate pre-finished wood planks are installed independently in a staggered layout to provide continuity and avoid the typical expansion reveals. The long edges of each plank are grooved to allow for the mounting clips which can be screw fixed to a conventional furring channel or T-bar system.



- Standard felt reveal is black. Custom colours may be available (MOQs apply), or no felt for open ceiling designs or ventilation.
- Standard plank lengths of 2438mm (96"). Custom plank lengths up to 3658mm (144") available.
- Standard 20mm (0.78") plank spacing. Optional 10mm (0.375") or 25mm (1") spacing available.
- Staggered/random plank layout (similar to wood flooring) is recommended for the best effect.
- Standard selection of Au.diSlat™ Continuous planks configurations. Custom designs available through design coordination with Atkar Technical Staff.



Acoustics

In order to approve sound absorption capabilities, your Au.diSlat™ Continuous planks can be specified along with acoustic insulation. Acoustic duct liner blankets or boards, can be purchased through Atkar or a local vendor. Some NRC values are provided below as a guide; however, there are many more factors contributing to the NRC value of a product, that must be considered on a per project basis.

- Type 'A' mounting, no insulation
 - Negligible
- E400, no insulation
 - -~0.20 NRC
- E400 or Type 'A' mounting, 1.5" fibreglass duct liner
 - -<18% Open Area: ~0.45 NRC</p>
 - 18%-30% Open Area: ~0.65 NRC
 - ->30% Open Area: ~0.75 NRC



Sustainability

Fire Rating

Standard Au.diSlat components meet or exceed Class C fire rating. If Class A fire rating is required, all components of the panel will conform to CAN/ULC test standards.

- Solid Wood: CAN/ULC-S102 Class A
- Standard Felt: CAN/ULC-S102 Class A

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Patterns

Refer to the table on the right for available standard Au.diSlat™ Continuous plank configurations. These patterns have been optimized for material yields. Some patterns may not be available with certain species.

Standard plank thickness is 19mm (0.75"), except in solid softwoods (Douglas Fir & Hemlock), which are 16mm (0.625") thick.

Standard plank length for veneer, plastic laminate, and painted MDF planks is 2438mm (96"). Solid wood planks are random lengths, unless otherwise specified.

Installation

Au.diSlatTM Continuous is installed progressively by means of a hat clip provided by Atkar. This clip can be fastened to T-bar, or to wood or metal furring. Clips should be spaced at max 610mm (24") on centre and, where possible, should be installed at plank joints to keep them flush. Atkar recommends a hairline reveal (1-2mm) at plank joints where they meet end-to-end. Perimeter planks will need to be either glued or pin –nailed in place, or screwed from behind. Felt rolls are provided separately and are installed by inserting the felt into the grooves at one end of a row of planks and pulling it through to the opposite end.
